DON WEBER CELEBRATES 20 YEARS OF SERVICE AS THE CEMETERY SUPERINTENDANT!

Since 1999 Don Weber has rung the chapel bells for over 100 funerals. He coordinates with funeral directors, sets and maintains stones, and restores the gravesite of new burials. All this in addition to the maintenance of over 2,600 burial records. His watchful eye and relationship with the community are vital to maintaining the security of the property.

Don has significant handyman skills. During his time at the cemetery, he has done quite a bit of restoration work on the chapel (built in 1882) and the superintendent's house (built 1890) and keeps both buildings in excellent condition. Beyond the general mowing, trimming, raking, snow removal, and maintenance of our 7 acre property, Don has considerable knowledge concerning tree care and maintenance.

If you have visited the cemetery lately you will have probably noticed Don's latest project of restoring the "God's Acre" area in the rear of the cemetery. He has spent many hours uncovering 100 sunken markers and has either reset the ones that survived or created new ones to designate the graves. The burials in this area date back as early as 1882 and were mostly infants and children. When completed, this area will have a fresh new look with new grass and each grave marked.

In addition to his duties at the cemetery, Don has a small landscaping and handyman business and comes highly recommended. Keep him in mind if you have small jobs or need a reliable lawn guy. You can reach him at Journeyman Enterprises (410) 746-4264. Don doesn't have much spare time, but when he does, he enjoys hunting, fishing and spending time at his cabin in West Virginia.

Immanuel Cemetery is blessed to have such a dedicated and hard working individual who truly cares about our beautiful cemetery and chapel. Thank you, Don, for everyone you have helped and all the things you have fixed painted, rebuilt, replaced, removed and restored over the past 20 years.
